Sponsorship obligations

As an approved sponsor, it is your responsibility to ensure that all applicable sponsorship obligations are satisfied for the duration of your sponsorship approval, or in some cases for a different period as specified in the relevant regulation. If you do not comply with these obligations, there may be serious consequences. The department may:

- issue an infringement notice to you
- bar you from accessing program for a period
- cancel your approval as a sponsor
- pursue civil litigation against you should the sponsorship obligations not be met.

Subject to legislation passing, if you fail to satisfy an obligation and are sanctioned by the Department, information that identifies the sponsor, breach and sanction applied will be published on our website.

Notification of sponsor changes

Sponsors must notify us if specific changes occur that may impact their sponsorship. You can do this through the online form in ImmiAccount. Information on the types of changes you need to report, and how to report them is available on our website immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/employing-and-sponsoring-someone/existing-sponsors

Evidence of labour market testing for non-immigration purposes

Outside of the immigration application context, Australian law may impose labour market testing requirements for particular industries to ensure that Australian workers are given priority.

The Building Code 2016, for example, imposes certain requirements on employers when they seek to employ persons to undertake building work who are not Australian citizens or permanent residents. For more information, visit Australian Building and Construction Commission website www.abcc.gov.au

Prospective sponsors are encouraged to ensure that they are familiar with any such requirements before considering nominating an overseas worker for a specific position.
