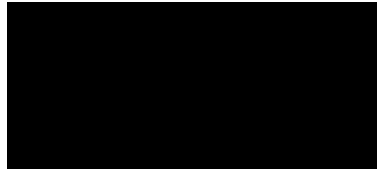

**Notification of approval as a Temporary Business Entry Standard Business Sponsorship - Aus Business**

As an approved sponsor you may make an application for approval of a nomination. Lodgement of this application should be done electronically via our website, [www.border.gov.au](http://www.border.gov.au)

The person whom you wish to nominate (i.e. the proposed primary sponsored person) should proceed with lodging an application for a subclass 457 (Temporary Work (Skilled)) visa if they are not already the holder of a subclass 457 visa.

To establish whether the person you are seeking to nominate is already the holder of a valid subclass 457 visa, you are advised to contact the person directly.

**Changes to your circumstances**

As a sponsor you must tell us about any changes to your circumstances including if a primary sponsored visa holder ceases employment with you and if there are any changes in your address and/or contact details.

As a sponsor you also have obligations to provide particular additional information to the Department when a certain event occurs.

This information must be provided by registered post or e-mail, to a specified address and within 28 calendar days of the event occurring.

### Period of approval

Regulation 2.63 of the *Migration Regulations 1994* (the Regulations), provides for the period of time for which an approval as a standard business sponsor or temporary work sponsor can be granted. In full, regulation 2.63 states:

- (1) For subsection 140G(2) of the Act, a kind of term of an approval as a standard business sponsor or temporary work sponsor is the duration of the approval.
- (2) The duration of the approval may be specified:
  - (a) as a period of time; or
  - (b) as ending on a particular date; or
  - (c) as ending on the occurrence of a particular event.

Guidance under policy provides for a period of standard business sponsorship approval of five (5) years commencing from the date of approval.

Standard business sponsorship approval has been granted to [REDACTED] PTY LTD from 11 May 2017 to 11 May 2022.

### Sponsorship obligations

As an approved sponsor, it is your responsibility to ensure that all applicable Sponsorship Obligations are satisfied for the duration of your sponsorship approval, or in some cases for a different period as specified in the relevant regulation. If you do not comply with these Sponsorship Obligations, there may be serious consequences. The department may:

- cause an infringement notice to be issued to you
- bar you from accessing program for a period
- cancel your approval as a sponsor
- pursue civil litigation against you should the Sponsorship Obligations not be met.
